1. Objectives

The objectives of this MOU are:

The scope of this MOU covers the following areas:

- **FDPs:** The Parties will jointly organize FDPs on emerging topics and technologies in engineering disciplines. The FDPs will be designed to enhance the knowledge, skills and competencies of the faculty members of both the institutions. The FDPs will be conducted either online or offline or in a blended mode as per the convenience and availability of the resource persons and participants. The duration, frequency, venue, fees, certificates and other details of the FDPs will be decided mutually by the Parties.
- **Workshops:** The Parties will jointly organize workshops on practical aspects and applications of engineering concepts and tools. The workshops will be aimed at providing hands-on experience and exposure to the faculty members and students of both the institutions. The workshops will be conducted either online or offline or in a blended mode as per the convenience and availability of the resource persons and participants. The duration, frequency, venue, fees, certificates and other details of the workshops will be decided mutually by the Parties.
- **Seminars:** The parties will jointly organize seminars on current issues and trends in engineering domains. The seminars will be intended to provide a platform for sharing ideas, insights and experiences among the faculty members and students of both the institutions. The seminars will be conducted either online or offline or in a blended mode as per the convenience and availability of the resource persons and participants. 


6. Amendment

- B. **SIHMCT** is engaged in service of 20 years with college name referred as **SUN INSTITUTE OF HOTEL MANAGEMENT & CATERING TECHNOLOGY** in Visakhapatnam District.

I. OBJECTIVES OF MOU:

1. To promote & enhance academic interest between **SIHMCT** and **SDC**.
2. To provide advice for implementation of quality of education between **SIHMCT** and **SDC**.
3. To promote research /continuing education activities between parties.
4. Access to Information on research / education resources.
5. Access to Centers of Excellence of the college
6. Technical support in projects related to science and Management from senior faculty or experts

7. Guidance for specific issues in terms of Project design and development etc. from the senior faculty or experts.
8. To refer or depute faculty for specific programs as Resource persons.

II. TECHNICAL AREAS OF COLLABORATION:

- A. A continuing quality improvement program to improve quality of teaching staff in both parties.
- B. Providing academic interaction by delivering special lectures at both Institutes on topics of relevance to modern industry.
- C. Provide necessary help in organizing workshops, conferences and personality development programs at both parties for enhancement of skills in respect of faculty, staff and students.
- D. To provide training programs for Students & Staff.

III. TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The cost of development of infrastructure at both parties should be borne by themselves.
2. For the visits related to advice & consultancy, travel and other expenses of faculty & staff shall be reimbursed by both the parties on mutually agreed terms.
3. The faculty of both parties can use library facilities for a short time.
4. Both parties agreed to help identify and invite the faculty members & researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
5. This MOU may be amended, removed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time.
6. Either party should have the right to terminate this MOU upon 30 days prior written notice to the other Party.

A. CONFIDENTIALITY:

The SIHMCT and SDC agreed to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the parties as being confidential which is obtained from either party or created during the performance of MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other party. The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data processed by either party before entering into this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

B. COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the program on its behalf who will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

C. TENURE AND TERMINATION

This MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for **Two years**, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice to the other institution 30 days in advance.

D. ARBITRATION CLAUSE



6. Amendment

This MOU may be amended by mutual consent of both the parties in writing. Any amendment to this MOU will be signed by both the parties and will form part of this MOU.





7. Arbitration

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into and executed on this day of August 2022 at Visakhapatnam by and between SAMATA DEGREE COLLEGE, VISAKHAPATNAM (hereinafter called "SDC"), represented by its Principal, having its office at Sangivalasa, Visakhapatnam which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the ONE PART

AND

APT IT Solutions., (hereinafter referred to as the "APTITS") a company registered under the Companies Act, 1956, through its Program Manager, Hyderabad having office at 3rd Floor, Sahithi Arcade, S R Nagar, Hyderabad-500038 (which expression, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, shall be deemed to mean and include their executors, administrators and assigns), party of the SECOND PART.

Whereas, SDC has initiated to provide competency based employability enhancement skills for Technical & Management courses as approved / Recognized by appropriate Government Authority & Whereas APT IT Solutions is required to perform the role and function of providing hands on skill training to **Degree Students and Computer Sciences and all its related areas**. Whereas the First Party has to nominate the number of students for the various programs offered by APTITS and Whereas the Second Party has expressed its keen interest and desire to be a key partner in the execution of this program in terms of the objectives of the scheme and policy as highlighted and specified in the said program and particularly in view of the desire and interest of APTITS to join and partner with SDC in providing competency based skills through its training center in Visakhapatnam.

WHEREAS both parties have held discussions and agreed for collaboration for conducting training Under this MOU and in GENERAL for Technical & Management Courses whereby APTITS will impart the requisite training and award credits for the training conducted on its own, to the registered students. THEREFORE, both the parties hereby agree that the Training Center at Visakhapatnam of APTITS, as approved and recognized by APTITS and SDC from time to time shall be known as an act / perform the role of "Training Providers" in GENERAL for Technical & Management Courses initiated by SDC on the following terms and conditions :

1. That APTITS agrees that Training center in Visakhapatnam set up by APTITS and herein after to be referred as "APTITS-TP" shall act and perform the role of Training Provider to provide hands on skill training in specific sector such as Information Technology and Management courses and all its related areas.
2. That APTITS agrees and undertake that its "APTITS-TP" conduct skill training in specific sector such as Information Technology and Management courses and all its related areas and shall perform following functions:
 - a. Announce the schedule of skill training modules for calendar year.
 - b. Register students for the modules and upload the same on APTITS website.
 - c. Conduct the skill modular training.
 - d. Conduct Examination / evaluate the student, award the grade indicating completion of Training and uploading the same on the APTITS website for verification.
 - e. The APTITS-TP recognized and approved by APTITS may register students as provided by the SDC.
3. The APTITS-TP as specified in the Memorandum of Understanding, may take flexible training timings and schedule in consultation with SDC

4. The APTITS-TP shall announce and inform through its website, the schedule of the Skill Modules it plans to offer in the academic year concerned for the information of the prospective students and it shall accept the students as provided by SDC.

5. The APTITS-TP shall be entitled to the fees as mentioned in the Table 1 below.

6. Interested students shall be encouraged for Internship, Project, Certified courses in Engineering and Management streams during MOU period.

7. The APTITS-TP will conduct appropriate training sessions as per the following pedagogy.

a) These various programs on different topics under this project will focus on practical hands-on training in field / practical supplemented with structured academic content that shall be provided online and may be supplemented with appropriate theory sessions to the students of SDC in Technical streams.

b) Practical sessions shall be held in ONLINE mode that shall expose the students to various Technologies in terms of their operations.

c) Academic content shall focus on the various operational procedures / facets of the technologies present in the APTITS related to the practical sessions in an attempt to provide the student with high end technical skills,

1. INTERNSHIP / Project (6 weeks): 10 Theory sessions of two hour each (20 hrs) & 20 Practical sessions of 2 hours each (40 hrs)

2. INTERNSHIP/Project (4 weeks) : 5 Theory sessions of two hour each (10 hrs) & 15 Practical sessions of two hours each (30 hrs)

3. Online Certificate Program (8 weeks) : 8 Practical sessions of four hours each (32Hrs).

This program is offered mainly on IT related topics:

Project Management, SDLC, Database Management, Using Technologies Java, DotNet, PHP.

4. Seminar: Four Hours session

1) INTERNSHIP/Project

However, the new courses will be designed in accordance with the demand from SDC administration and fee also decided in negotiation with both parties accordingly

e) In brief, the training sessions shall introduce the trainee to various SDLC aspects. And in management perspective include personality management, Enterprise Analysis etc.

f) The online content / theory sessions provided shall support material (soft copy) for the practical sessions in terms of descriptions.

g) In addition to that an over view on improvement of communication skills, soft skills and preparation of curriculum vita etc., will be imparted as an additional advantage.

h) FORCE MAJEURE:

If at any time, during the continuation of this Memorandum of Understanding, the performance in whole or in part, by other party, of any obligation under this is prevented or delayed, by reasons of war, or hostility, acts of public enemy, civic commotion, sabotage, act of state or direction from statutory authority,

explosion, epidemic, quarantine restriction, strikes and lock-outs, fire, floods, natural calamities or any act of God (hereinafter referred to as event), provided notice of happenings of any such events is given by the effected party to the other within 7 calendar days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall, by reasons of such events be entitled to terminate the Memorandum of Understanding, nor shall other party have any such claims for damages against the other in respect of such non - performance or delay in performance. Provided service under the MOU shall be resumed as soon as practicable, after such event comes to an end or ceases to exist. The decision of APTITS as to whether service may be so resume (at the time frame within which the service may be resume) or not, shall be final and conclusive. However, the Force Majeure events noted above will not in anywhere cause extension in the period of the MOU.

i) Dispute resolution and arbitration:

a. In case of dispute there shall be an arbitration committee comprising of representative/s nominated by Board of Management, SDC, Visakhapatnam and representative/s nominated by Head of APTITS, Hyderabad. The decision of the arbitration committee shall be binding on both parties.

b. The Memorandum of Understanding shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Visakhapatnam only.

ii) Arbitration Clause:

Except as otherwise provided elsewhere in the contract, in the event of any disputes, controversy, or differences arising out of or relating to this MOU, or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof between the parties, such party or parties shall make a request to the other party or parties to amicably settle such differences or disputes and parties shall thereupon make every effort to settle the same amicably within a period of 60 (sixty) days from the date of making of such request.

The venue of the arbitration proceeding shall be Visakhapatnam.

1. Duration of the Program: 8 weeks after graduation and 12 weeks for students who are currently enrolled: The training may be spaced between 5th, 6th, and 7th semesters for the currently enrolled students. (50 Hands on Experience of 2 hours each + 10 Theory Sessions of 2 hours each making a total of 120 hours; the distribution of which may be decided in consultation with the technical campus.

Fee for the courses:

- a. Fee for APTITS Certified courses: Fee shall be limited and not more than Rs.12, 000 + GST per semester per student totaling to Rs. 36,000 + GST per student across the three semesters.
- b. Fee for Internship (4 weeks) course: Fee shall be limited and not more than Rs.5, 000 +G ST.
- c. Fee for Internship (6 weeks) course: Fee shall be limited and not more than Rs.8, 000 + GST.
- d. Fee for Online certificate program course: Fee shall be limited and not more than Rs.15, 000 + GST.
- e. Fee for Seminar: Nomination of Expert from APTITS at free of cost (for MOU universities/ colleges only)

PAYMENT TERMS:

- a) For APTITS Certified courses, Internship and Project trainings, fee will be directly paid by the student to APTITS.

- b) For On-Campus, training fee will be paid directly by the SDC to APTITS, VISAKAHAPATNAM in the form of NEFT to APTITS Visakhapatnam before ten days.
- c) Amount paid / deposited cannot be refunded under any circumstances.

On-Campus trainings:

SDC will arrange accommodation to conduct training classes in the SDC premises and Hands on Experience will be conducted online.

2. Relevant Documents

A Comprehensive report (Attendance / Evaluation etc.) of the training shall be furnished by APTITS-TP, Visakhapatnam to SDC.

4 Process Methodology

- a. SDC may inspect the training programs randomly by authorized persons and binding on APTITS TP , Visakhapatnam to extend all support to SDC, Visakhapatnam
- b. APTITS TP, Visakhapatnam will rectify any shortcomings observed during the visit on an immediate basis.

A summary of the all programs that shall be delivered under this Memorandum of Understanding are as per schedule II.

5. The APTITS - TP will evaluate the students for the Training Skills and award grades and such grade sheet be submitted to the SDC.

6. The APTITS - TP shall maintain a record of the registered students and certificates issued and upload the same on the APTITS web portal.

7. No Confidentiality: There shall not be any confidentiality of any information disclosed to by both parties to each other, either in operationalizing this Memorandum of Understanding or for the purposes of implementing this Memorandum of Understanding. The information sought under Right to Information Act or otherwise by any student, shall be promptly made available.

8. The APTITS agrees and undertakes that the APTITS - TP as recognized and approved by SDC shall act as Training Provider in terms of the Memorandum of Understanding signed by them with the SDC and the Memorandum of Understanding to be signed between the SDC and the Training Provider shall provide the details regarding the schedule of operation, in order to protect the interest of students and all concerned stakeholders.

9. The APTITS shall participate, operate and execute the scheme strictly in accordance with the scheme in GENERAL for Technical & Management Courses initiated by SDC and shall not indulge in any violation of the scheme.

10. Both the parties shall indemnify and keep the other party indemnified and harmless against any and all claims, actions, proceedings by third party (including all costs, expenses, damages / losses) arising out of or in connection with this MOU due to breach of any provisions of this MOU by such party or as a result of any act of negligence / omission or commission on part of such party and / or its employees, agents etc.

11. The present Memorandum of Understanding can be terminated by the SDC / APTITS by giving a notice of one month to APTITS / SDC without assigning any reason in this regard and the SDC / APTITS shall have no claim against each and its officials on account of termination of such Memorandum of Understanding. However, the responsibilities and duties of both parties in respect of the common students already registered shall not end with the termination of the Memorandum of Understanding, and these will remain valid in totality until completion of evaluation of the already registered students and reporting of their results by both parties.

12. Validity of MoU:

This Memorandum of Understanding is effective from the date signed by both the parties will be valid for a period of FIVE years until determined, suspended or terminated earlier.

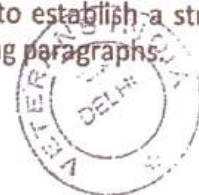
