



Divyangjan Policy

Physical constraints can never be a hindrance for the students of Samata Degree College, who believes in quality education at all levels. Regardless of physical handicaps, the College motivates students towards higher education. A number of government-directed and volunteer efforts are aimed through the Divyangjan Policy that aims to uplift the Right to Education.

SAMATA DEGREE COLLEGE offers the following facilities in the favour of DIVYANGJAN:

1. Ramp/Rail: Our institution has a barrier-free environment in the important buildings for the differently-abled students. The ramp/rail is placed at the main entrance and exit of the building so that any disabled student can easily identify and access it. The ramp is so wide that a wheelchair user can use it without any problem.

2. Toilets: Sizable floor area allows for freedom of movement by the students. Floor is slip resistant. Separate toilets have been constructed for boys and girls with different disabilities.

3. e-Classrooms: To allow smooth studies to Divyangjan students, our institution has provided an e-classroom in the campus.

4. Scribes for Examination: Our institution will make or allow the scribes for those students who need while writing their exams. Controller of Examinations will allow the student, on the recommendations of the Director & I/c Principal allow extra time to disabled candidates for answering papers at the university-level examinations. Extra time up to 20 mins per hour may be given so that the candidate can complete the paper.

5. For candidates who are eligible to use the facility of scribes, the Director & I/c Principal shall permit the appointment of scribes as under:

- (a) The scribe shall not be an employee of the college/centre where the examination is being held.
- (b) The scribe shall not be a near relative of the student appearing for the examination.
- (c) Educational qualifications of the scribe would be lesser than those of the student.
- (d) A proforma with declaration in the above-mentioned format the institute be obtained from the scribe. The proforma signed by the scribe shall be forwarded to the institute.
