Research Policy

1. Policy Statement

The Research Centre is committed to fostering a culture of quality research, innovation, and academic excellence. It encourages faculty and postgraduate students to undertake ethical, relevant, and impactful research that contributes to knowledge and societal development.

2. Objectives

- Promote quality research among faculty and students.
- Encourage interdisciplinary and collaborative research.
- Support research publications, projects, patents, and consultancy.
- Facilitate research funding from government and other agencies.
- Ensure adherence to research ethics and academic integrity.

3. Research Ethics

All research shall be conducted with honesty, transparency, and respect for ethical standards. Plagiarism, data fabrication, and other forms of research misconduct are strictly prohibited.

4. Research Support

The College shall provide guidance, infrastructure, and opportunities for research through workshops, seminars, collaborations, and assistance in securing research grants. Funding for publications will include:



- For every article published in a reputed journal with ISBN or ISSN number a total incentive of 1000/- shall be awarded irrespective of the number of authors.
- For presenting an article at a seminar, on-duty shall be granted to only one faculty/presenter irrespective of the number of presenters.
- The faculty who attending seminars outside the station shall be reimbursed for travelling expenses (Train sleeper class or equivalent), limited to one claim per faculty member per semester
- Articles presented by the faculty members at seminars organised by external colleges shall be featured in the college newsletter.

5. Publications

Researchers are encouraged to publish their work in reputed peer-reviewed journals and present their findings at conferences. Publications shall follow accepted standards of authorship and academic integrity.

6. Monitoring

The Research Centre shall monitor research activities, maintain records of publications and projects, and review research performance periodically to promote continuous improvement.

7. Review

This policy shall be reviewed periodically updated as necessary to align with institutional goals and regulatory requirements.
