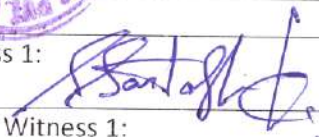
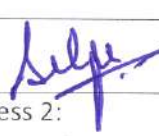

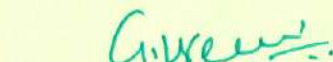

The First Party has agreed to collect and hand over dry recyclable waste, including paper waste and old records generated in its college, under the **Swachh WOW Andhra Pradesh Chapter**.

The Second Party is engaged in the collection, segregation, and recycling of dry recyclable waste in coordination with ITC.

Both Parties desire to collaborate for environmental protection and promotion of sustainable waste management practices.

1. PURPOSE OF THE MoU

This MoU is entered into to establish a synergistic alliance between **Samata College** and **Suraj Krishna Greenaries** for the social cause of recycling dry waste and protecting the environment.

2. DURATION

This MoU shall be valid for a period of **Two (2) Years** commencing from the date of signing of this MoU, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

3. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF SAMATA COLLEGE

- a. To ensure **source segregation of dry and wet waste** at the college premises through teaching staff, housekeeping staff, and students.
- b. To hand over paper waste, dry recyclable waste, and old records to Suraj Krishna Greenaries at mutually agreed rates as mentioned below:
 - Paper Waste & News paper: ₹12/kg
 - Board files: ₹5/kg
 - Carton boxes: ₹10/kg
 - Hard plastic (pipes, chairs, white drinking bottles): ₹12/kg
 - Low-grade plastic: ₹5/kg
 - E-waste: ₹18/kg
 - Iron : 20/kg
- c. To form the **Swachh WOW Andhra Pradesh Chapter** in the college with student volunteers and adopt nearby schools or colonies to promote source segregation.
- d. To provide students for internship under the **WOW Program** and motivate students to bring dry recyclables such as paper, plastic, and metal from their homes for donation to the WOW initiative.

e. To install **colour-coded bins** for waste segregation at appropriate locations within the college premises.

4. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF SURAJ KRISHNA GREENARIES

a. To train students and housekeeping staff on source segregation and promote segregation practices among other students.

b. To collect dry recyclable waste and old records from **Samata College** and transport the same to the **Dry Resource Collection Centre (DRCC)** without spillage.

c. To undertake sorting, baling, and environmentally appropriate disposal of dry waste.

d. To coordinate with ITC and arrange dispatch of sorted recyclables for recycling at its own cost.

e. To make payment to **Samata College** directly into its bank account based on accurate weighment and category of waste collected. Payment shall be made **within 15 days** from the date of collection.

On request, the franchisee may provide **notebooks and stationery** equivalent to the value of dry recyclable waste collected.

5. PERFORMANCE OF OBLIGATIONS

a. This MoU represents an understanding between the Parties in letter and spirit.

b. Any notice or communication under this Agreement shall be in writing in English and delivered personally or sent by email to the addresses mentioned herein.

- a) Segregation of waste at source.
- b) E-waste management (through 3rd party).
- c) MoU with Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation for waste management.

a) Segregation of waste at source: -

Samata Degree College has focused on the segregation of waste at source. For that purpose, color-coded bins are used for collection of Bio-degradable and Non-bio-degradable wastes. However, dry waste like plastic, papers etc. are also collected separately through bins which are placed in different areas of college campus.

b) E-wastage of the (through 3rd party): -

The E- waste of the college is collected by the Suraj Krishna Greeneries through their authorized persons for further processing of E-waste. For that purpose, the college authority has made an MOU with Suraj Krishna Greeneries.



a) MoU with Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation: -

The solid waste of the college is collected by the Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation through their authorized persons and are transported to Municipality dumping ground. For that purpose, the college authority has made an MOU with Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation.

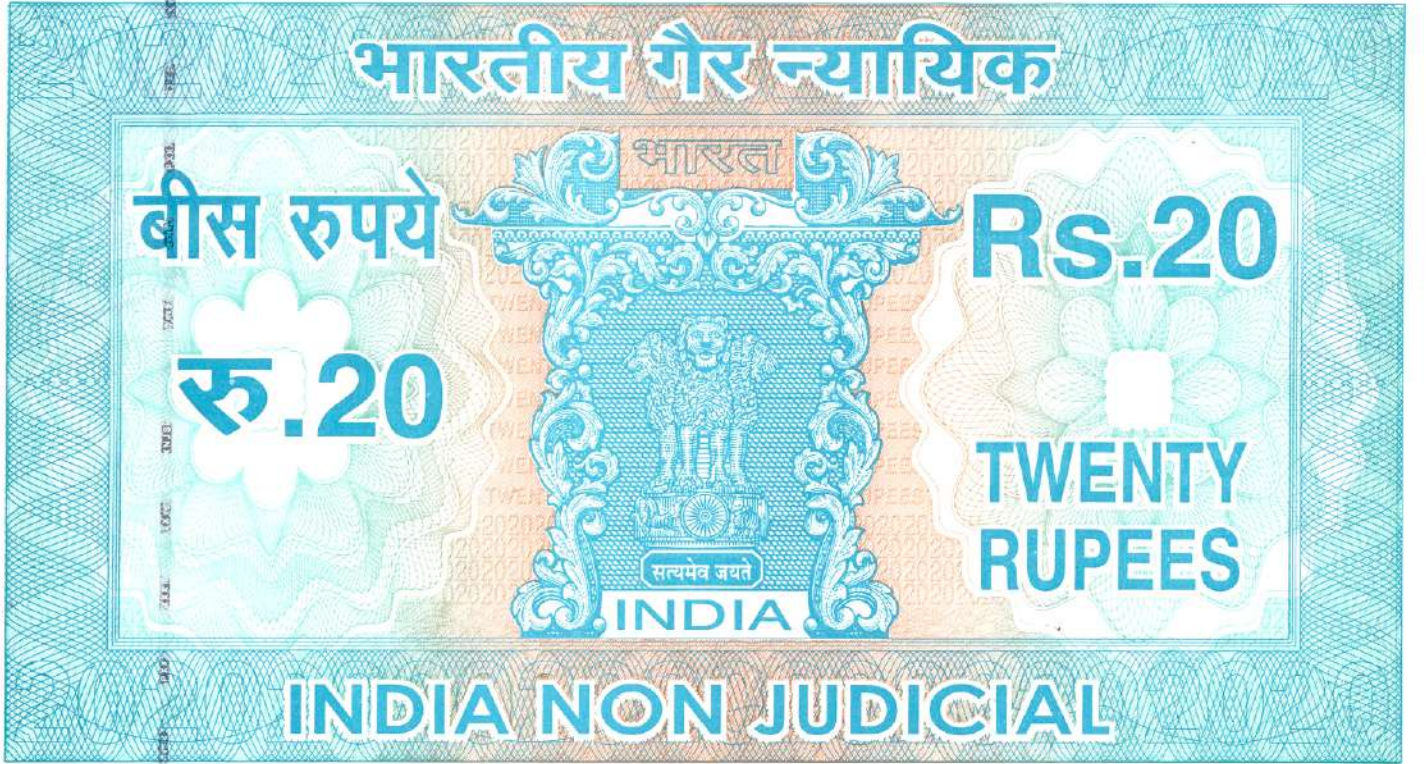
